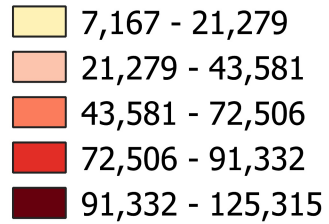

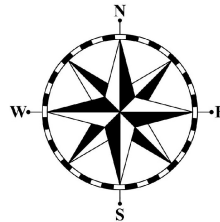
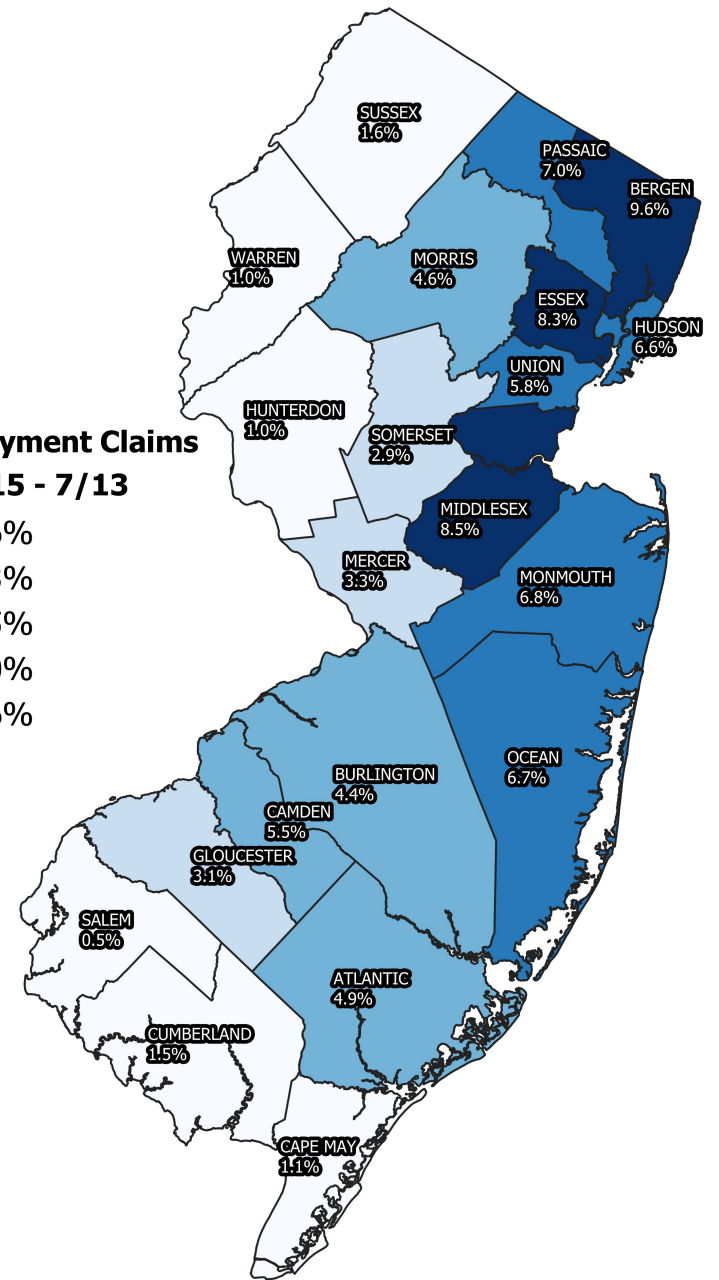
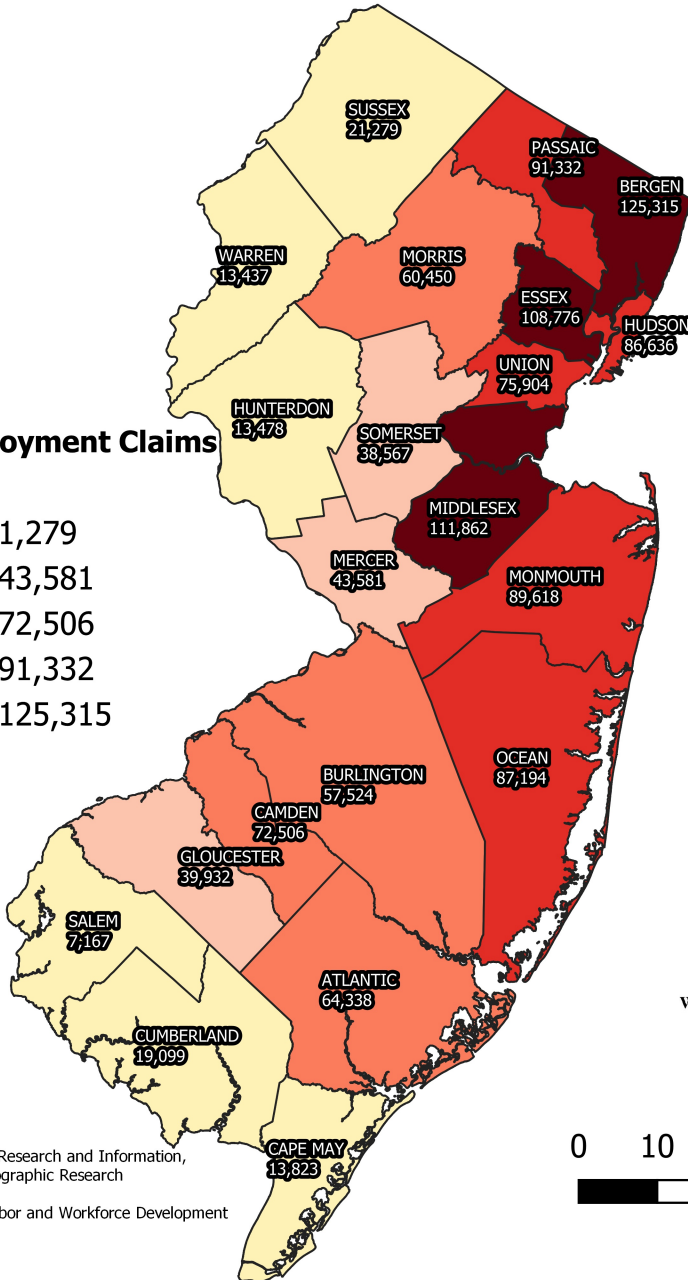
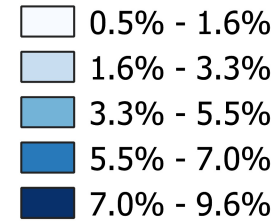

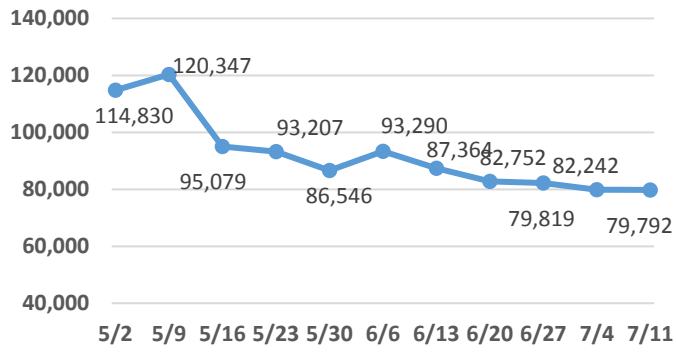
Professional & Business Services Continued Claims



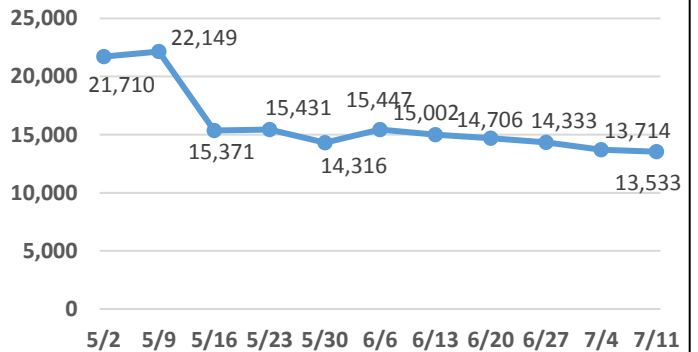
Financial Activities Continued Claims



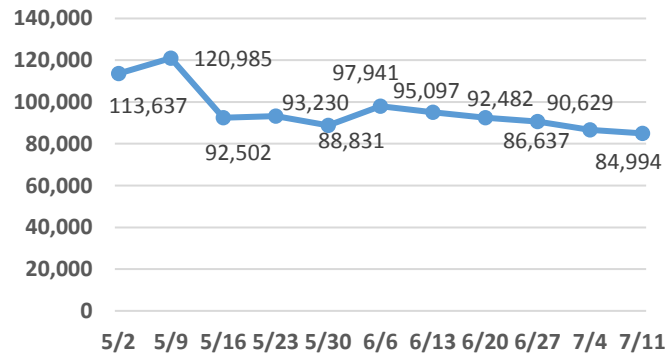

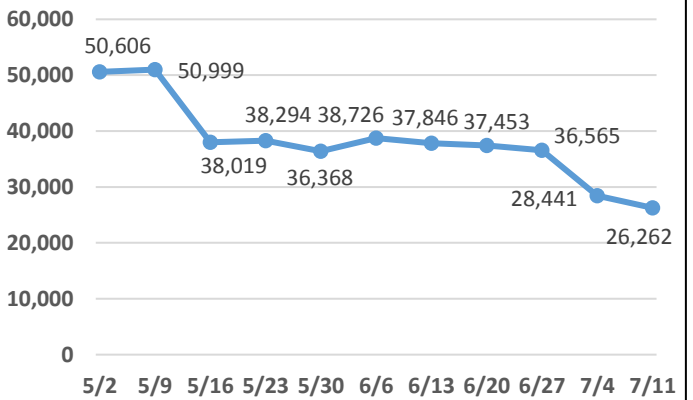
