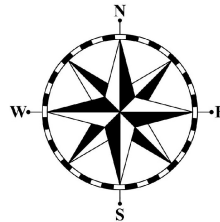
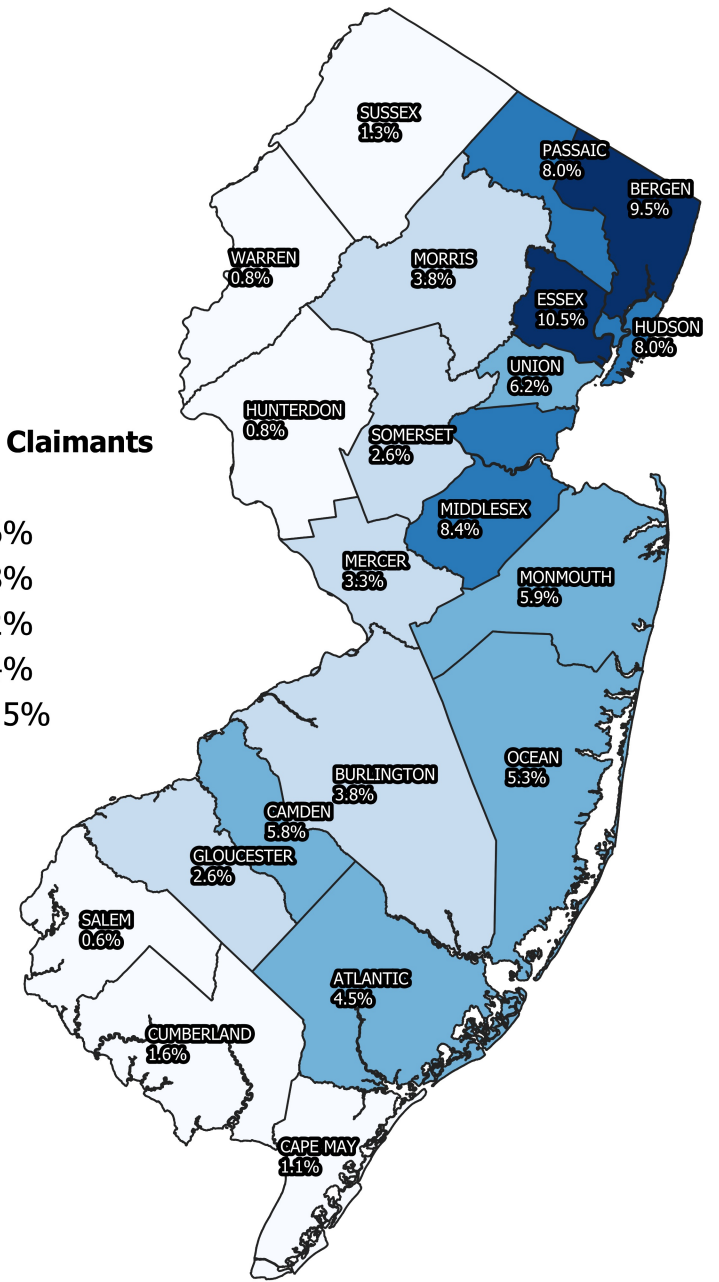
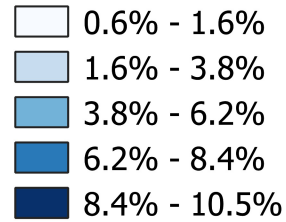
## N.J. Initial Unemployment Claims by County
