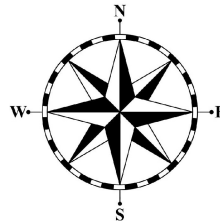
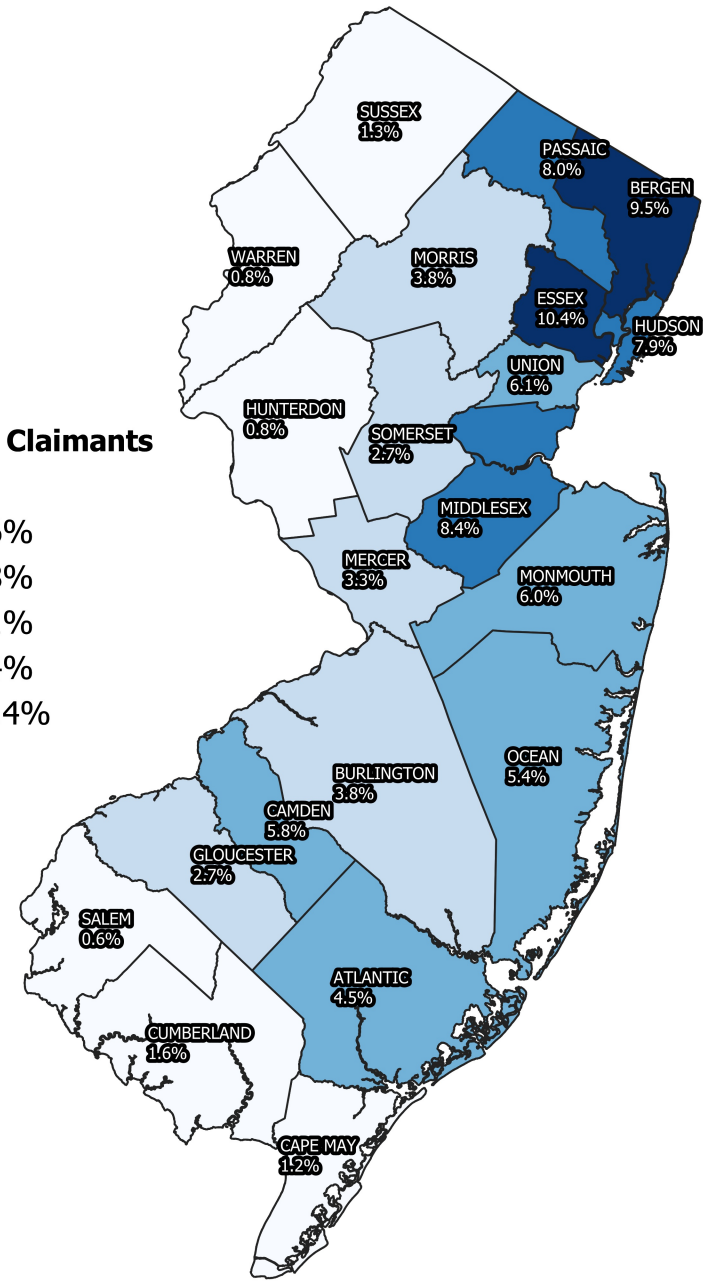
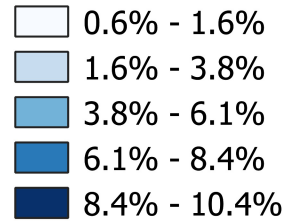

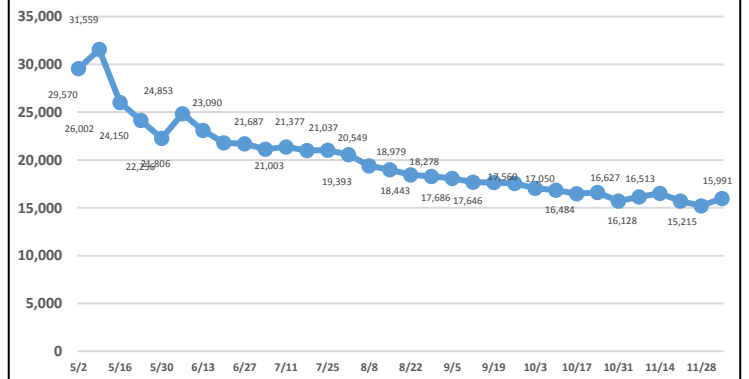

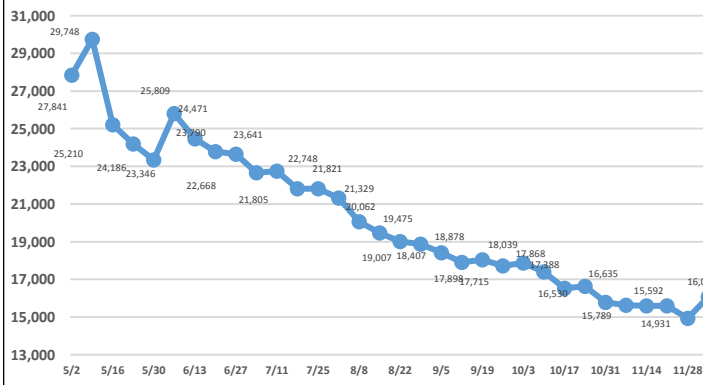
Construction Continued Claims



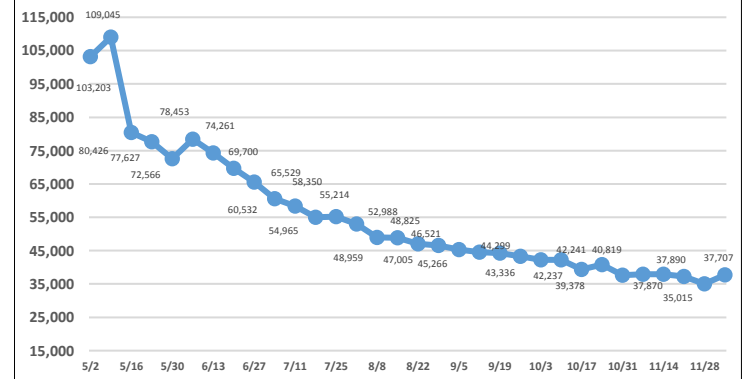
Manufacturing Continued Claims



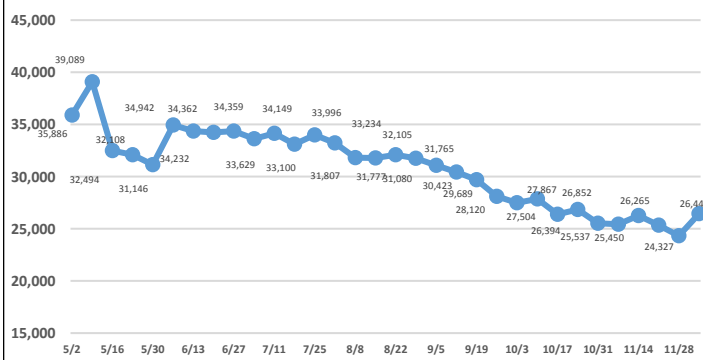
Wholesale Trade Continued Claims



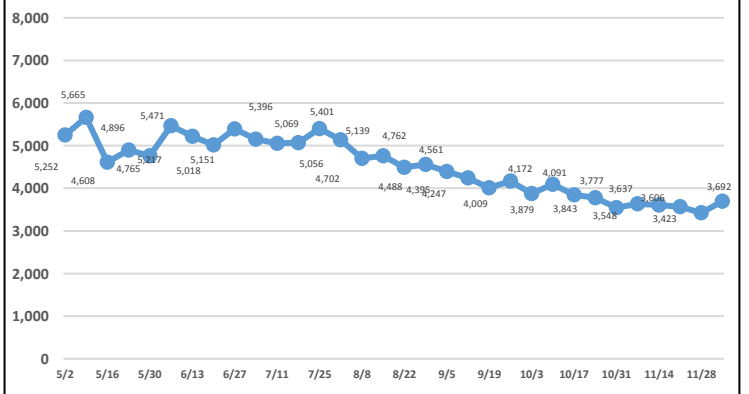
Retail Trade Continued Claims



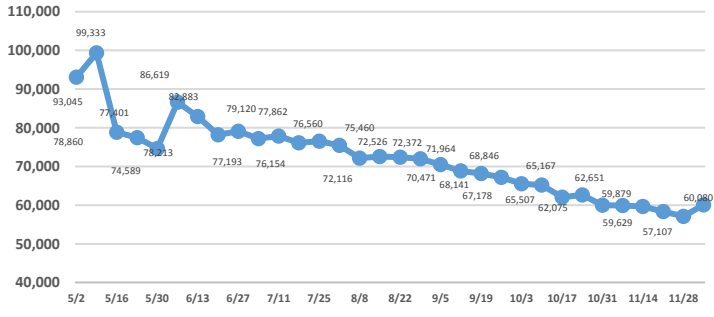
Transportation/Warehousing Continued Claims



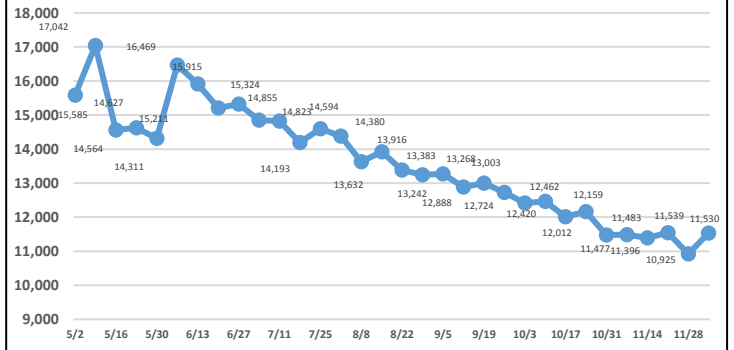

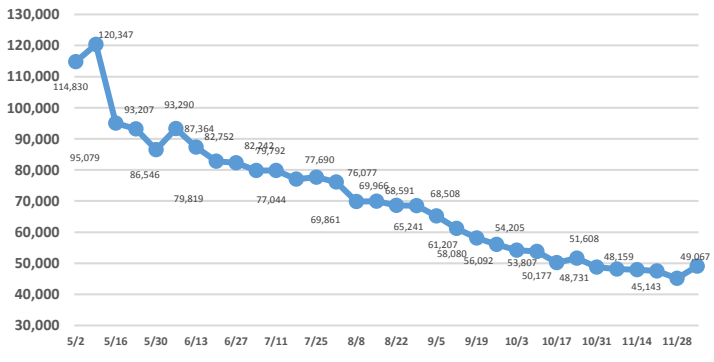

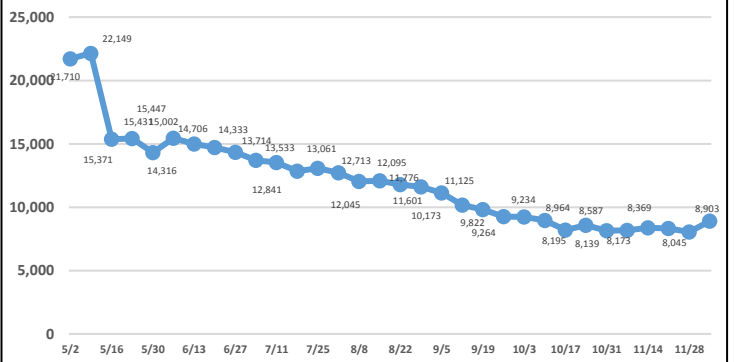

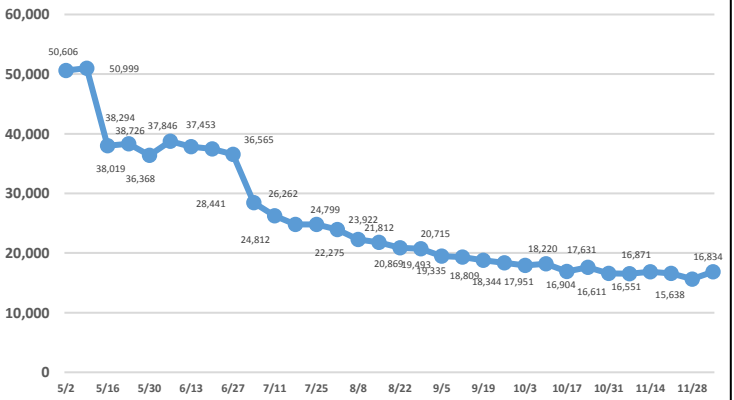

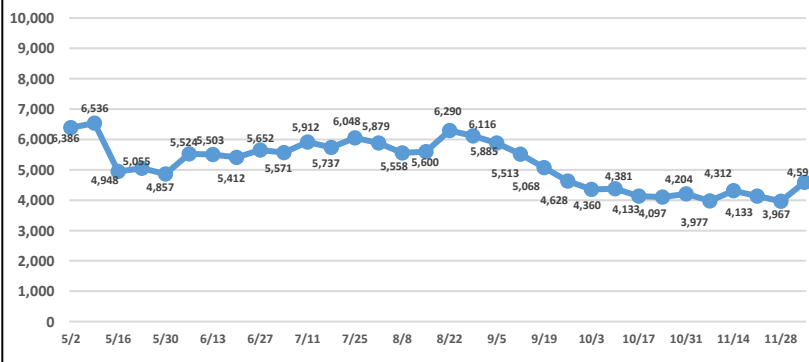
