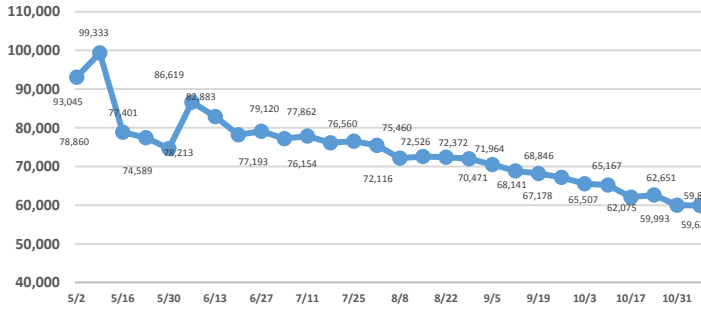
### U.I. Continued Claimants 11/14/20



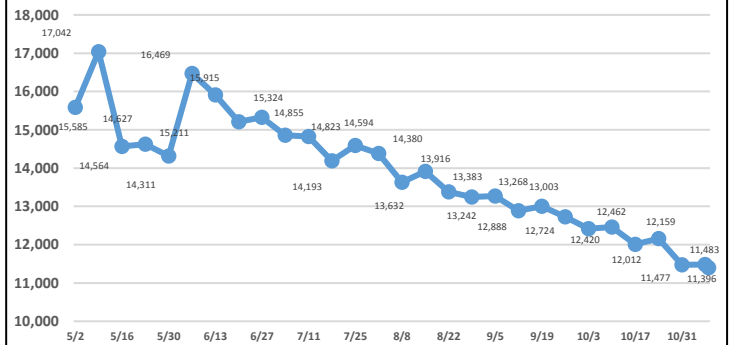

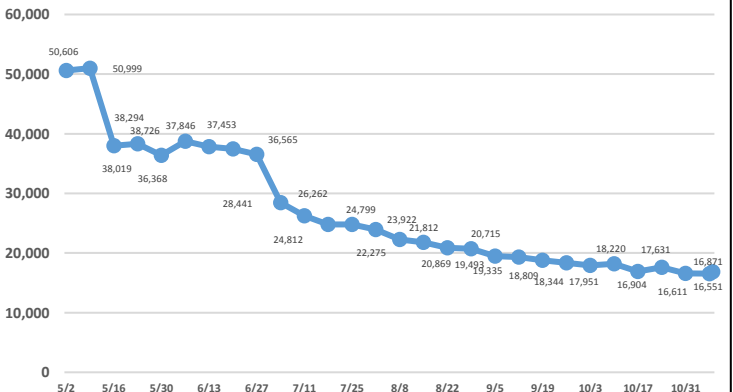

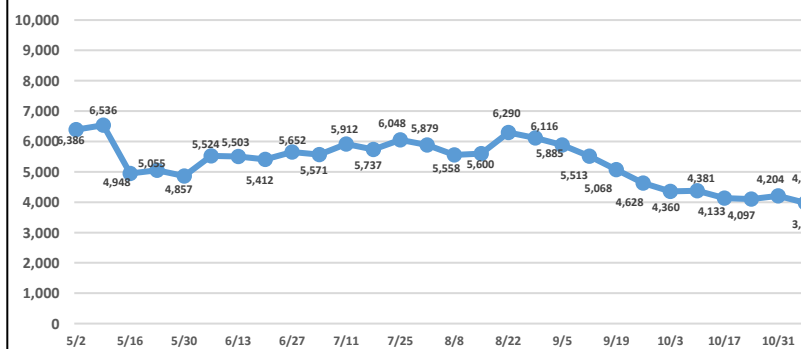
