

EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ALLAMUCHY, WARREN COUNTY, NJ, AS RECORDED IN THE OFFICIAL MINUTE BOOK

The Board of Education of the Township of Allamuchy in the County of Warren, NJ, convened in Regular Session August 22, 2011 at 7:35 PM in the Allamuchy Township Elementary School at Allamuchy, NJ.

G. Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights

Mr. Pelletier made a motion, seconded by Mr. Cramer to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS P. L. 2010 ch. 122, an act known in part as the "Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights" was signed into law effective January 5, 2011;

WHEREAS said act imposes new mandates on local school districts that are not funded by the Legislature;

WHEREAS Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 5 of the New Jersey Constitution provides that laws enacted by the legislature that are not funded and that require local governmental entities, including Boards of Education, to raise funds through local tax levy in order to comply with such mandates may be declared to be ineffective and to have expired;

WHEREAS Article VIII, Section II, paragraph 5 of the New Jersey Constitution establishes a Council on Local Mandates with jurisdiction to decide whether a mandate is unconstitutionally unfunded;

WHEREAS the mandates of the "Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights" will require the Allamuchy Township Board of Education to raise funds locally through the local tax levy;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 22nd day of August 2011 by the Allamuchy Township Board of Education that a complaint be filed with the New Jersey Council on Local Mandates with regard to the mandates imposed pursuant to P.L. 2010 ch.122 and that the President of the Board of Education sign such complaint on behalf of the Allamuchy Township Board of Education.
