## **DGE Announces March 2013 Casino Win Results**

### **ATLANTIC CITY —**

Based upon filings with the Division of Gaming Enforcement, total casino win was \$238.5 million in March 2013 compared to \$266.5 million last March. Table game win was \$65.6 million, reflecting a change of 12.8% compared to the prior period. Slot machine win was \$172.9 million, reflecting a variance of 9.6% due in part to the impact of a \$7.2 million, or 20%, reduction in promotional gaming credits wagered compared to the same period last year.

Casinos incurred \$17.4 million in taxes on their gross revenues in March. That money, 8 percent of taxable gross revenue, goes into the Casino Revenue Fund, which pays for programs that benefit qualifying senior citizens and people with disabilities. In addition, the casino industry incurred \$3.0 million in reinvestment obligations based on their gross revenues for the month. Casinos are required to reinvest 1.25 percent of gross revenues in projects approved by the Casino Reinvestment Development Authority.

For the first three months of the year, casinos won \$656.0 million reflecting a change of 12.1% from the same period last year.

Win reflects the net amount of money won by casinos. It is not profit.
