### • Chairperson's Report

# Committee Reports

### • Ad Hoc Committee on Board Membership – Michele Christina

Michele Christina reported that the Ad Hoc Committee met on October 25, 2022. Present were Michele Christina, Ira Whitman, Joann Held, Dana Haymes and Paul Stofa. She noted

that the SRPL Board is not at full capacity as set forth in the SRRA and at least one current Board Member is looking to retire. Having less than the full complement of board membership may detrimentally impact the Board's ability to act.

The Committee decided it would be helpful to reach out to Janine MacGregor, the former Executive Director of the Board, and Jessica Sponaugle, the Department Liaison to the Governor's Office, to better understand the process of identifying and approving proposed Board Members. At this time, it seems that legislative committee reviews are often the point where prospective applicants get held up.

The Committee has also identified some groups that may be interested in getting the word out about Board vacancies, including the LSRPA, Environmental Departments at state colleges / universities, and the Environmental Law Section of the NJ Bar Association.

The Committee plans to meet with Janine MacGregor and Jessica Sponaugle on December 19. The Committee will draft a job description for SRPL Board members which can be distributed to groups to help recruit prospective members.

Ira Whitman noted that if an attorney were to join the Board as a Member, they should be aware of what functions the attorney may or may not be allowed to play; for example, representing LSRPs before the Board for complaints may not be permitted.

Dana Haymes noted that the application of Charles Stebbins to be a Board Member is pending.

Joann Held noted that the Committee would also like to better define the process for applying to be a Board Member and identify how the Board can assist in expediting the process.

#### • Licensure Committee – Kathi Stetser

Kathi Stetser reported that the invoices for the 2023 annual license fees will be sent to LSRPs soon. Please make sure your contact information is up to date.
