• Chairperson's Report

Paul Stofa acknowledged the passing of DAG Nielsen Lewis in January. Niel provided many years of dedicated service to the SRPL Board. The SRPL Board thanks him for his service, and sends condolences to his family. Joann Held noted that she and Mark Pedersen attended the memorial service for Niel on February 4.

Paul Stofa noted that there will be a meeting to discuss Independent Professional Judgment organized by the Contaminated Site Remediation and Redevelopment Program on February 22, 2023, and a Brownfield Coalition of the Northeast Environmental Law Seminar on March 1, 2023. Some Board Members will be attending these events and speaking in their individual capacities, not on behalf of the Board, but will report back to the Board.

• Executive Director's Report

Dana Haymes reported that some LSRPs have expressed concern about obtaining enough live, in-person CEC credits for license renewal, as many continuing education programs are only held online. The Board has addressed this situation by narrowing the definition of Alternative Verifiable Learning Format to only those programs that are offered online, but not synchronously. A program is not considered to be Alternative Verifiable Learning Format if it is attended synchronously with its presentation, even if attended remotely online.

O Motion by Phil Brilliant, on behalf of Kathi Stetser, Chairperson of the Licensure Committee, in the matter of the LSRP License Renewal Application discussed in closed session, to find that a guilty plea to the crime of indecent exposure under §3127 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes (18 Pa. C. S. §3127) is a guilty plea to a crime involving moral turpitude under N.J.S.A. 58:10C-7.d(6) of the Site Remediation Reform Act as amended in 2019, and to authorize the Licensure Committee to work with Counsel to develop a recommendation on what action the Board may take in regards to the license renewal under all applicable laws and regulations.
