This day in NJ military history: Remembering the Harlem Hellfighters

May 14, 1918: Trenton native Pvt. Needham Roberts, an African American soldier serving with the segregated 369th Infantry Regiment of the New York National Guard, assigned to the French Army, was badly wounded when a post he manned with Sgt. Henry Johnson was attacked by a German patrol. Both men continued to fight with rifles, knives and hand grenades, killing 20 German soldiers, and were awarded the Croix de Guerre by the French army.
