MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS/ADMINISTRATIVE NOTES:

- **Advisory Role:** Serves as the JFHQ Commander's primary staff advisor for monitoring, protecting, integrating, and managing communication and cyberspace requirements, and the wing's portion of the CCMD's theater information grid
- Ensure assigned Mission Defense Team is trained and ready for steady-state and deployed operations
- Must have eligibility to serve at least 3 years in the position
- Must meet minimum USAF standards and overall image must exceed minimum standards; maintain a minimum score of 75 on the PT assessment
- Must have a Top Secret Security Clearance

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Maintain authority over functional reporting, deployment, and maintenance of communications and network systems/infrastructure. Facilitate coordination of required communications systems, activities and functions. Coordinate with the wing A2 and other directorates countering emerging cyber threats. Provide functional oversight to communications units. Coordinate with other directorates to identify and support steady-state, deployment related, and exercise communications requirements. Support plans development as a member of OPGs and LRPGs. Establish and lead a cross-functional Cyberspace Planning Team. Plan, monitor and report for assigned/attached communications systems across the full range of military operations. Serve as a liaison between other A6/S6/G6/N6/J6 entities.
