MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS/ADMINISTRATIVE NOTES:

- Advisory Role: Serves as the JFHQ Commander's primary advisor on all logistics, engineering, and installations matters, providing expert guidance and recommendations on resource allocation, readiness posture, and infrastructure capabilities, particularly those related to state-level operations.
- **Joint and Interagency Coordination:** Facilitates seamless logistical support and coordination between the Air National Guard, Army National Guard, state agencies (e.g., State Emergency Management Agency, Department of Transportation), federal agencies (e.g., FEMA, National Guard Bureau), and local authorities.
- Must have eligibility to serve at least 3 years in the position
- Must meet minimum USAF standards and overall image must exceed minimum standards; maintain a minimum score of 75 on the PT assessment

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Director of Logistics, Engineering, and Installations (A4) for the Air National Guard within the [State] Joint Force Headquarters (JFHQ) serves as the principal advisor to the JFHQ Commander on all matters pertaining to logistics readiness, maintenance, supply chain management, transportation, civil engineering, installation management, and environmental stewardship. This position is responsible for leading, managing, and directing the activities of the JFHQ Logistics Directorate (A4), ensuring the efficient and effective provision of logistical support to all JFHQ elements, Air National Guard units within the state, and support to state active duty (SAD) missions, homeland defense, homeland security, and support to civil authorities. The A4 is responsible for integrating logistical capabilities across all domains and functions within the JFHQ, coordinating with both the Air National Guard and Army National Guard elements, as well as state and federal agencies. The A4 also has a critical role in ensuring the readiness and sustainability of ANG facilities and infrastructure to meet mission requirements.
