DEFINITION:	<p>Under the direction of an Air Guard Fire Captain, or other superior officer in the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, during an assigned tour of duty, performs fire suppression, prevention, rescue, EMS, and other fire and rescue services at the Air National Guard Base and civilian airport; responds to actual or potential aircraft emergencies to prevent or extinguish fires on aircraft, airbase/airport facilities, and grounds; aids in emergency situations involving hazardous or toxic materials and spills; does other related duties as required.</p> <p>This position is for the Department of Military Affairs which will become effective on January 9, 2026.</p>

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:	<p>EDUCATION: Graduation from high school, vocational high school, or possession of an approved high school equivalency certificate.</p> <p>EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience involved in the extinguishing of fires and/or in performing fire prevention work.</p> <p>MEDICAL EXAMINATION: Appointees must take and pass a NFPA 1582 firefighter physical.</p>				
LICENSE / CERTIFICATION:	<p>Appointees must possess the following IFSAC and/or PRO BOARD certifications: Airport Firefighter, Firefighter II, Hazardous Material Operations. NOTE: Appointees must maintain all required certifications; failure to do so may result in disciplinary action or termination. NOTE: Appointees will be required to successfully obtain the following certifications: Driver/Operator ARFF, Driver/Operator Pumper and Driver/Operator MWS. Failure to obtain these certifications within the working test period may result in separation from employment. Appointees must possess current CPR and Emergency Medical Responder certification or higher. Appointees will be required to possess a valid US driver's license.</p>

RESIDENCY:	Effective 9/1/11, NJ PL 70 (NJ First Act), requires all State employees to reside in New Jersey, unless exempted under the law, or current employees who live out-of-state and do not have a break-in service of more than 7 calendar days, as they are "grandfathered." New employees or current employees who were not grandfathered and who live out-of-state have one year after the date of employment to relocate their residence to New Jersey or request an exemption. Current employees who reside in NJ must retain NJ residency, unless he/she obtains an exemption. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.
DRUG SCREENING:	If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care with the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, you may be subject to pre and/or post-employment drug testing/ screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing will be at your expense. Candidates with a positive drug test result or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the testing requirement will not be hired. You will be advised if the position for which you're being considered requires drug testing and how to proceed with the testing.
