Scope of Eligibility: Application will be accepted from all interested New Jersey Department of Military Veterans Affairs employees and outside applicants who meet the requirements listed below. Selection will be made from among the best qualified.

Note: Appointment to this may be made provisionally, pending the outcome of an open competitive examination (PAOC). If selected for the position and appointed PAOC, you will be required to apply for the open-competitive examination, when issued by the Civil Service Commission for this title, pass, and be reachable on the resulting eligible list to become permanent in the position. Appointees who fail to be reachable on the resulting eligible list are subject to removal.

Job Description: Under the limited supervision of a supervisory official in a state department or agency performs technical or scientific work, including field and office studies, surveys, inspections or investigations associated with the enforcement of laws and/or regulations and environmental review and control work or organizes and carries out programs/projects designed to study and evaluate environmental impact of specific projects on the environment; organizes and makes tests and reports to assess environmental impacts to include the physical, natural, and/or human environments and investigates environmental complaints concerning projects; conducts contract, grant and/or loan processing; does related work as required.

Civil Service Commission Requirements

Education: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in one of the Physical Sciences, Environmental Sciences/Studies, Chemical Sciences, Biological Sciences, Environmental Planning, Physical Geography or in Civil Engineering, Sanitary Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Agricultural Engineering, Mining Engineering, Industrial Engineering, or Bio-resource Engineering.

Experience: Two (2) years of experience in environmental control work including field investigations, inspection, and preparing reports on the environment or the preparation or review of Environmental Impact Statements.

Note: The following education requirements are applicable to positions in the Department of Transportation assigned to all programs except *Environmental Services Support Unit (ESSU)/Facilities Hazard Compliance Monitoring*.

Note: A Master's degree in one of the fields specified above may be substituted for one (1) year of the above experience.

License: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in the State of New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

Residency: Pursuant to the "New Jersey First Act" N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 (L. 2011, Chapter 70), newly hired public employees are required to reside in the State of New Jersey, unless exempted under the law. If you do not reside in New Jersey, you have one (1) year after you begin employment to relocate your residence to New Jersey.
