## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

## **DEFINITION:**

Performs tasks associated with development, operation, improvement, and/or maintenance of automated project management and control systems. Prepares manual and Computer Aided Design (CAD) drawings, specifications, cost estimates, engineering related memorandums and other documentation required by base, state, and federal agencies. Manages and utilizes surveying technology to include Geographic Information Systems (GIS), Global Positioning System (GPS) and Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS). Performs drafting duties. Interpret rough engineering sketches to produce working drawings using manual and CAD techniques. Produce architectural, structural, civil, mechanical, and electrical drawings. Update Base Comprehensive Plans (BCP) and maintains record drawings. Plot and produce drawings. Link computerized maps to databases displaying detailed information via the web. Create geographic coverage. Develop database structures. Create and populate feature codes. Link graphical data to relational databases. Develop query routines for end-user applications. Common Installation Picture (CIP) maintenance, map creation, and analysis of geospatial/GIS data. Performs surveying duties. Conduct reconnaissance, site location, construction, and mapping surveys while operating manual and electronic surveying equipment. Collect, convert, and present field survey data for civil engineering projects. Maintain equipment. Performs construction project administration, engineering and design inspection of facilities, roadways, and utilities for the 177<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing New Jersey Air National Guard, on a federal installation, to ensure that the needed system(s) will be constructed in accordance to plans and specifications, schedule, budget, and using agency requirements. Inspects construction work completed by electrical, mechanical, plumbing, structural steel, and general contractors for conformance with recognized standards and contract documents. Suggests improvements to the unit's procedures to enhance performance. Assist in establishing scopes of work for new design projects and in selecting consultants. Prepares a clear, accurate job record in logbook; lists inspections conducted, personnel on site, delivery of major equipment, strikes, causes of delays, and job problems.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:	Incumbent must be an active member of the New Jersey Nation Guard upon assignment to this position unless formally waived by the Chief of Staff, New Jersey Department of Military & Veterans Affairs. When the individual loses military status for any reason, his term of employment may be extended by the Chief of Staff in a civilian status until such time as the neumbent is eligible for retirement as a veteran under N.J.S.A. 43:15A-61 EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree. NOTE: Completion of Branch Officer Basic Course or equivalent. EXPERIENCE: Three (3) years of military experience. One (1) year military experience at Battalion level or in a support unit. Supervisory experience desirable.

RESIDENCY:	Effective 9/1/11, NJ PL 70 (NJ First Act), requires all State employees to reside in New Jersey, unless exempted under the law, or current employees who live out-of-state and do not have a break-in service of more than 7 calendar days, as they are "grandfathered." New employees or current employees who were not grandfathered and who live out-of-state have one year after the date of employment to relocate their residence to New Jersey or request an exemption. Current employees who reside in NJ must retain NJ residency, unless he/she obtains an exemption. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.					
DRUG SCREENING:	If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care with the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, you may be subject to pre and/or post-employment drug testing/ screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing will be at your expense. Candidates with a positive drug test result or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the testing requirement will not be hired.
