NJARNG Deploys Soldiers, Helicopters to Support Wildfire Operations in Louisiana

WHO: 1-150th Assault Helicopter Battalion, New Jersey Army National Guard WHAT: Eight Soldiers and two UH-60 Black Hawk helicopters depart for wildfire

Eight Soldiers and two UH-60 Black Hawk helicopters from the 1-150th Assault Helicopter Battalion, New Jersey Army National Guard are preparing to support firefighting operations in western Louisiana. They will join multiple states' Guard assets as state and local agencies work to contain the <u>largest wildfires in Louisiana history</u>.

"The Emergency Management Assistance Compact is the mechanism which enables states to share critical resources," said Brig. Gen. Lisa J. Hou, D.O., The Adjutant General of New Jersey. "New Jersey National Guard is proud to be able to answer the call to help our neighbors in need. That's what we do."
