## EQCC eMS DEVELOPING AND IMPLEMENTING SUBCOMMITTEE

- 3. PURPOSE: The purpose of the eMS Subcommittee is to develop and maintain the NJARNG eMS Implementation Plan.
- 4. PERIOD: Until dissolved by the EQCC Chairman.
- 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: 31 March 2015.

## 6. ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. The chairman will schedule meetings. All eMS Subcommittee members are required to attend. An agenda will be published prior to each meeting.
- b. The eMS Subcommittee will report its progress to the EQCC at all normally convened meetings. The first report will include the proposed date for completion of the first draft of the NJARNG eMS Implementation Plan.
  - c. The eMS Subcommittee is required to:
    - (1) Perform annual eMS management reviews as required by the EQCC.
- (2) Review Environmental Performance Assessment Survey (EPAS) findings and suggest corrective actions to the EQCC for maintaining the Installation Corrective Action Plan (ICAP).
- (3) Report progress on items such as milestones, roadblocks, compliance with Federal, State, DoD and DA environmental requirements and metrics, compliance with NJARNG EQCC established Targets and Objectives, and progress with EPAS items of non-compliance.
- (4) Provide written report to the EQCC with recommendations for changes and modifications to the eMS and ICAP for review and approval.
