**SUBJECT:** Appointment of New Jersey National Guard Community Health Promotion Council (CHPC)

1. The NJARNG CHPC will meet quarterly to support the analysis and development of the Ready and Resilient (R2) Program, which includes Suicide Prevention, Army Substance Abuse Program and Resiliency for the New Jersey Soldiers, Families, and civilian employees. The CHPC is an enduring senior-level advisory body focused on R2 and substance abuse governance, policies, structure, processes, and programs. This Council should act rapidly to assess, adjust, and approve all tasks related to R2 and substance abuse, and serve as the integration and synchronization element.
