DEFINITION: Under direction of a Director of Nursing Services, Nursing Homes in the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, assists in the administration of nursing services to patients in a long term care facility; does related work as required.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in a course of nursing approved by the New Jersey State Board of Nursing.

EXPERIENCE: Six (6) years of experience as a Registered Nurse, two (2) years of which shall have included supervisory experience involving the rehabilitative, psychiatric or geriatric care of patients.

LICENSE: Applicants must possess a valid license as a Registered Nurse in the State of New Jersey.

Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

<u>RESIDENCY LAW:</u> Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 (L. 2011, Chapter 70), also known as the "New Jersey First Act," which became effective September 1, 2011, all persons newly hired by the Executive Branch on or after that date shall have one year from the date of employment to establish, and then maintain principal residence in the State of New Jersey. New Jersey State employees hired prior to September 1, 2011 who transfer from within the Executive Branch or from another State of New Jersey appointing authority without a break in service greater than seven days but who reside outside the State of New Jersey are not required to change their principal residence to New Jersey in order to comply with the act.
