

Office of Drug Monitoring & Analysis Drug Monitoring Initiative (DMI) COVID-19 Resource Guide





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Summary

The spread of COVID-19 has negatively impacted statewide infrastructure and reduced the availability of a wide number of Health and Prevention Sharing Network (HPSN) resources, which are essential for DMI partners and the individuals they serve.

In response to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic, NJ's Drug Monitoring Initiative (DMI) has created a "New Jersey Resource Guide" to provide DMI partners and the public with links to relevant resources for a variety of topics.

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NJ Office of the Governor COVID-19 Updates – *updates and briefings from the NJ Office of the Governor regarding COVID-19*

COVID-19 Links – *national, statewide, and local links/information to all things COVID-19 related (e.g. viral statistics, alerts, maps)*

COVID-19 Testing Sites – *list of testing sites by county for COVID-19*

Access to Naloxone (Narcan) – *list of programs that are still offering naloxone in NJ*

Recovery Support & Meetings – *list of active (many of which are online) recovery and support services for stakeholders and those suffering from substance use disorder*

Mental Health Support – *behavioral health information and resources to help those suffering from a mental illness*

Crisis Hotlines – *list of hotlines to call for different purposes (e.g. National Suicide Hotline, Poison Help Hotline, National Domestic Violence Hotline, The Trevor Project etc.)*

National Resources – *links to live information hubs and maps that provide real-time information regarding COVID-19 from sources such as the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO)*

State Resources – *statewide links to information such as guidance for travelers, resources for healthcare providers, opioid-related data, and other updates*

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Social Services – *List of Department Health and Social Services by County*

Food Banks– *list of food banks by county*

Emergency Housing– *list emergency housing by county*

Senior Services – *list of services for seniors (e.g. where to find groceries, meals, and support)*

Veterans – *List of Resources for Veterans*

First Responders – *List of Resources for First Responders (law enforcement, fire, EMS)*

College Resources – *list of resources for college students (e.g. storage and food assistance and financial support)*

Job Searches – *support services and portals to obtain employment*

Business/Employee Resources –*resources to guide both employers and employees for financial assistance and filing paperwork/forms*

Home Expenses Information –*programs to assist in financial hardships during COVID-19*

In-Home Education – *online education resources for all ages (e.g. music lessons, art classes, online classes, and guidance on how to talk to adolescents about COVID-19)*

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Entertainment – *online sources for virtual tours, concerts, kid shows, comedy, theatre, art shows etc.*

Self Care – *Online resources Everyone (e.g. seniors, parents, first responders etc.)*

Health & Wellness – *online fitness, health, and wellness resources*

Volunteering/Donation Opportunities – *organizations that are looking for volunteers and/or donations*

NJSP DMI COVID-19 Resource Guide –COVID-19 Testing Sites by County

GENERAL INFORMATION

At this time, testing is prioritized for individuals who are sick with symptoms of fever, cough and shortness of breath where they need hospitalization, those who are close contacts of confirmed COVID-19 cases, and individuals who traveled to/from highly affected areas.

If you do not have symptoms, testing is not recommended. Complete this [self-assessment](#) to learn what to do.

Community-based testing sites - These sites are open to all New Jerseyans who are experiencing symptoms of respiratory illness

County testing sites - These sites may be restricted to residents or first responders of a specific county. Some also require an appointment and/or prescription from a healthcare provider.

Private testing sites - To access testing at these sites, you must contact your doctor or healthcare provider.

NOTE: Each testing site operates on a schedule and has specific requirements. Please check with that site before visiting as you may be turned away

Patients do not need to receive a written order to visit the respiratory illness tent, but are encouraged to contact their primary care physicians and receive direction from them regarding further testing and evaluation prior to visiting the tent. Individuals who choose to visit the respiratory illness tent should drive directly to the Emergency Department entrance of the Hunterdon Medical Center and remain in their car as a clinician approaches them to evaluate their medical needs. Visitors with respiratory illness or symptoms of the coronavirus will be instructed to follow signs to the rear of the hospital where the tent is located, where again they will be asked to remain in their car until being approached by a clinician who will show the driver where to park and how they will be brought into the tent for screening.</p>	<p>10 am to 6pm</p>
