**SUBJECT:** **Administrative Order 2020-01**

On March 9, 2020, Governor Philip D. Murphy declared a State of Emergency and a Public Health Emergency with respect to the spread of Coronavirus disease 19 (COVID-19) in the State of New Jersey.

Today I have signed Administrative Order 2020-01, which extends the expiration date of any driver license, vehicle registration including any temporary vehicle registration certificate, or inspection sticker that is due to expire between March 31, 2020, and May 31, 2020, by two months. Specifically, as follows:

- a. Expiration date March 31 extended to May 31
- b. Expiration date April 30 extended to June 30
- c. Expiration date May 31 extended to July 31

Please carefully read the Administrative Order and be sure to note that the extension provided therein does not restore a driving or registration privilege that is subject to a valid order of suspension.
