SUBJECT: **International Registration Plan's Charter Bus "Apportioned Plate" Requirement (New Jersey Statute N.J.S.A. 39:3-6.12 (b) and New Jersey Administrative Code N.J.A.C. 13:18-2.1 and N.J.A.C. 13:18-2.2**

Effective January 1, 2016, the International Registration Plan (IRP) was amended to remove the exemption for buses used in the transportation of chartered parties. Non-government owned buses transporting chartered parties to any destination outside of the state in which they are registered are required to be registered under the IRP and display the corresponding "Apportioned" plates.

Chartered Party is defined as:

...a group of persons who, pursuant to a common purpose and under a single contract, have acquired the exclusive use of a motor vehicle to travel together as a group. N.J.A.C.13:18-2.1
