SUBJECT: **Electronic Temporary Vehicle Registration Tags**

Please be advised that automobile dealers statewide are now issuing a new form of Temporary Vehicle Registration Tag (*see attached*). The new eTemp Tag is printed on-demand and placed in the license plate position on the rear of a vehicle. Features of the new tag include issue and expiration dates, vehicle make/model and the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN). After final testing completes this month, access will be provided on the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) for law enforcement to verify the validity of a registration number in real time.

Vehicle owners are required to carry a temporary registration card in the vehicle. This card is printed on the same paper as the temp tag and will be given to the customer at the time of purchase by the issuing dealership.

The current style of resident temp tag that is displayed on the interior, rear window of the vehicle will remain in use until July 30, 2012 in order for automobile dealers to exhaust their supplies. The current style of non-resident temp tag will remain in use until July 19, 2012. After those dates, the old style resident and non-resident temp tags will no longer be considered valid for use on any vehicle. Motorcycle owners will also receive the new temp tags but will only be required to carry, not display them.

A few key facts about the numbering system that will be used in the new eTemp Tags are:

- All eTemp Tags will have seven characters/numbers.
- Resident eTemp Tags begin with a letter and the first letter the MVC will use will be an "F."
- Non-resident eTemp Tags will always end in an "N." This sequence will remain constant.
