TO: NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, SOUTH JERSEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE AUTHORITY, AND UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE REGARDING AMENDMENTS TO FLASHING AMBER LIGHT PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Pursuant to N.J.A.C.13:24, effective immediately, please note the following amendments to the requirements for a flashing amber light permit:

- New Jersey Department of Transportation (DOT) employees, South Jersey Transportation Authority (SJTA) employees, New Jersey Turnpike Authority (NJTA) employees, and United States Postal Service (USPS) rural route letter carriers are no longer required to obtain a permit to operate a flashing amber light on a personal vehicle owned/leased by the employee or a member of his or her family, while used by the employee in the performance of his or her official duties. Supervision for the employee's use of the flashing amber lights will be provided by the respective employee's principal department or government agency.
- DOT, SJTA and NJTA contractor employees, subcontractor employees, consultant employees and sub-consultant employees, who are required to utilize a vehicle owned or leased by him or her in the performance of his or her assigned duties at a worksite of the applicable department or authority, are eligible for flashing amber light permits. The fee per vehicle for which a permit is being requested is \$25.00.
