New eTemp Tag Process Now Available

To All New and Used Vehicle Dealers:

The new Electronic Temporary Vehicle Registration Tag (eTemp Tag) piloted by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC) over the last several weeks is now live and available for use by all New Jersey licensed motor vehicle dealers. This new system allows dealers to request and print temp tags on demand as needed.

With eTemp Tags, the MVC has eliminated the need for a dealer to:

- Visit an MVC office for temp tag purchases
- Securely store temp tag inventory
- Manually log temp tags
- Mail hard copies of issued temp tags to the MVC
- Be the primary source of vehicle owner information associated with a temp tag

Each dealer can securely control employee access to the system by assigning certain functions and is able to view reports of any and all temp tag activity occurring at their location(s). The new system allows eTemp Tags to be created 24-hours-a-day, 7-days-a-week at a dealer's convenience.

To make the eTemp Tag transition as easy as possible, dealers will have until June 30, 2012 to continue issuing any paper temp tags that they have in stock, as well as purchase additional stock at MVC agencies (while supplies last). The MVC is helping dealers integrate the new system into their existing business processes by simultaneously allowing them to issue eTemp Tags during this same period.

Beginning on July 1, 2012, dealers will no longer be permitted to issue the old style temp tags. Additionally, non-resident temp tags may not appear on vehicles after July 19, 2012. No old style, resident temp tag may appear on a vehicle after July 29, 2012.
