

CHANGE OF STATUS ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION

New Jersey law allows you to express your wish to donate your organs and tissues for transplant or medical research upon your death by designating the words "Organ Donor" to appear on your New Jersey driver license or non-driver identification card. This designation is for individuals 14 years of age or older, whether or not the minor is emancipated.

To document your decision to register as an organ and tissue donor, provide the information below completely and legibly (please print) and return it to the address at the bottom of this form. To complete this form you must have either a New Jersey driver license, permit, or non-driver identification card. If you do not have those items, please visit <u>www.donatelifenj.org</u> to become an organ donor online. Your family and friends can also make their donor designation online by visiting <u>www.donatelifenj.org</u>.

If you would like to have the change in your Organ Donor Status reflected on your New Jersey driver license, permit, or New Jersey non-driver identification card, you must visit a Motor Vehicle Agency and request this change in person. You must present the required six (6) points of identification as well as verification of your address. Remember that you must confirm your decision each and every time you renew your driver license, permit, or non-driver identification card.
