**NOTICE TO ALL LICENSED NEW JERSEY MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS REGARDING THE WAIVER  
OF THE DEALER OBLIGATION REGARDING NECESSARY REPAIRS IMPACTING VEHICLE  
INSPECTION**

Pursuant to P.L. 2017, c.182, effective November 1, 2017, when a retail purchaser waives the dealer's obligation to effect repairs necessary to obtain a certificate of approval for the motor vehicle pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:8-2 or N.J.S.A. 39:8-3, the waiver must now include a brief description of the known defects that may need to be resolved in order to obtain the certificate of approval.
