- Expand regenerative farming practices and production
- Provide training for young and emerging farmers

FOODSHED ALLIANCE

Project

- Reintroduces high-value grain crops
- Wholesale Markets for milling, distilling, and malting
- Advocates sustainable and regenerative farming practices
- Develops capacity to produce, process, and market grains



Northwest Jersey Food Processing & Innovation Center, \$150,000 plan conformance grant Project

- Location: Oxford Township, Warren County
- Redevelops former trash incinerator site
- •Implementation plan, regional hub for food processing
- Business and marketing plans
- Facilitates advancement of new products, packaging, and distribution

- Secure legal structure for property acquisition
- Prepare preliminary building design
- Develop plans and procedures for innovation
