#### Township of Randolph Petition for Plan Conformance Final Draft Consistency Review and Recommendations Report

**Please take notice** that the Highlands Water Protection and Planning Council (Highlands Council) is now accepting public comments on the Township of Randolph's Petition for Plan Conformance and the Final Draft Consistency Review and Recommendations Report, prepared by the Highlands Council staff for consideration by the Highlands Council in its review of the Petition for Plan Conformance of the Township of Randolph, Morris County, New Jersey. Written public comments will be accepted through January 4, 2013, via email at [maryjude.haddock-weiler@highlands.state.nj.us](mailto:maryjude.haddock-weiler@highlands.state.nj.us), via facsimile at the number listed above, or by mail to the address listed above. Equal consideration will be given to comments regardless of how they are received.

Model documents comprising the various elements of a standard Petition for Plan Conformance were posted to the Highlands Council website between April 2009 and June 2010. The Township of Randolph's Petition for Plan Conformance was deemed administratively complete on February 8, 2010 and posted to the Highlands Council website on February 18, 2010. **Please take further notice** that, subsequent to the close of public comment, the Township of Randolph's Petition for Plan Conformance, in conjunction with the Final Consistency Review and Recommendations Report and all public comments received, will be the subject of a public hearing held by the Highlands Council pursuant to sections 14 and 15 of the Highlands Act. After receiving any additional public comments provided during the hearing, the agency may approve, reject, or approve with conditions the Petition for Plan Conformance. **The public hearing has been scheduled for the January 17, 2012 meeting of the Highlands Council, which will be held in the Highlands Council Chester offices (address above) beginning at 5:00 pm.** A meeting agenda will be posted prior to the meeting, on the Highlands Council website at:

**Please take further notice** that, as the Township of Randolph has submitted a petition for Substantive Certification to the Council on Affordable Housing, public comments regarding that Plan's consistency with the Regional Master Plan may be submitted to the Highlands Council, while any specific comments on the formal approval of that Housing Element and Fair Share Plan (a Plan Conformance Petition requirement) may be submitted to the Council on Affordable Housing.
