Starting at 12:01 am, January 25, 2026 and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:4-98.9, this Emergency Order temporarily lowers all posted speed limits above 35 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour on state and interstate highways. This remains in effect until conditions warrant aligning with Executive Order No. 8 issued by Governor Mikie Sherrill. State and interstate highways with a posted speed limit of 35 miles per hour or less will not be affected by this Traffic Regulations Emergency Order.

All speed limits affected by this Emergency Order shall be treated as 35 miles per hour statutory speed limits under N.J.S.A. 39:4-98 for the purposes of law enforcement.

This Order shall take effect at 12:01 A.M. Sunday, January 25, 2026 and shall remain in effect until such time that this Order is terminated.

The provisions of this Emergency Order shall maintain traffic safety during emergency conditions detailed in the Governor Mikie Sherrill Executive Order NO. 8.
