**All-Hazards Situation Unit Leader Course Overview:**

The goal of this course, L0964 - Situation Unit Leader, is to provide federal, state, and local-level emergency responders with an overview of key duties and responsibilities of a Situation Unit Leader within the All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). Through this unit, students will learn the objectives of the course, be instructed on the use and purpose of Position Task Books, and receive Situation Unit Leader versions of these resources.

**Selection Criteria:**

Applicants will be selected based on properly completed applications, completed prerequisites, and whole community representation. **Class size is limited to 25 students.**

**Primary Audience:**

NIMS ICS All-Hazards Position Specific training should be completed by personnel who are regularly assigned to Functional, Support, or Unit Leader positions on Type 3 or 4 AHIMTs, or by those persons who desire to seek credentials/certification in those positions.
