## **Course Length:**

## **ICS 200 Course Overview:**

This 2-day course is designed to enable personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the Incident Command System (ICS). ICS-200 provides training on and resources for personnel who are likely to assume a supervisory position within the ICS.

## **Prerequisites:**

**The following courses are mandatory prerequisites to this course and must be included with your application. You will NOT be registered without proper required documents.**

- IS-100.C (Introduction to ICS)- available on FEMA as Independent Study
- IS-700.B (Intro to NIMS)- available on FEMA as Independent Study
- IS-800.D (National Response Framework, An Intro)- available on FEMA as Independent Study

Lodging will not be provided. Class size limited to 30.

## **Selection Criteria:**

Applicants will be selected based on properly completed applications, completed prerequisites, and whole community representation.
