ICS 300 Course Overview:

This 3-day course is designed to enable personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the Incident Command System (ICS). This course provides training on resources for personnel who require advanced application of the Incident Command System (ICS). This course expands upon information covered in the ICS-100 and ICS-200 courses.

Prerequisites:

The following courses are mandatory prerequisites to this course and must be included with your application. You will NOT be registered without proper required documents.

- ICS 100 (Introduction to ICS) most current version
- ICS 200 (Basic ICS) (Classroom Version)
- ICS 700 (Intro to NIMS) most current version
- ICS 800 (National Framework, an Intro) most current version

Additional Information:

Lodging will not be provided. Class size limited to 30.

Selection Criteria:

Applicants will be selected based on properly completed applications, completed prerequisites, and whole community representation.

Primary Audience:

Personnel assigned to an Incident Management Team (IMT), Incident Support Team, Incident Management Assistance Teams, County Emergency Management Coordinators or Emergency First Responders.
