# **BERGEN COUNTY**

#### **VOLUME/RATE**

- There were 25,068 Index offenses reported in Bergen County during 1993, revealing a decrease of 5 percent when compared to 1992.
- Violent crime decreased less than one-half of one percent and nonviolent crime decreased 5 percent.

# GLOUCESTER COUNTY

- There were 9,151 Index offenses reported during calendar year 1993, a decrease of 2 percent compared with 1992.
- Violent crime recorded a decrease of 5 percent while nonviolent crime decreased 2 percent.
- The crime rate for Gloucester County was recorded at 39.8 victims per 1,000 population, a 2 percent decrease over 1992.
- Rape decreased 22 percent to 56 as compared to 72 in 1992. Burglary increased by 6 percent.
- The value of property stolen, as a result of Index crimes, amounted to \$9.7 million, of which 33
  percent was recovered.

- There were 10,678 persons arrested during the year, representing a 4 percent increase when compared to the previous year.
- · Adult arrests increased 4 percent and juvenile arrests increased 6 percent.
- The total clearance rate for Index offenses was 21 percent; juveniles were responsible for 23 percent of those cases cleared.

# **HUDSON COUNTY**

#### **VOLUME/RATE**

- During the year, 36,257 Index offenses were reported to the police of the county, a decrease of 8 percent compared to 1992.
- Violent crime decreased less than one-half of one percent and nonviolent crime decreased 9 percent.
- The crime rate was recorded at 65.6 victims for every 1,000 persons, an 8 percent decrease when compared to the previous year.
- Murder and motor vehicle theft decreased 19 percent.
- Stolen property, from the commission of Index crimes, amounted to \$58.5 million, with 31 percent of this being recovered.

#### ARRESTS/CLEARANCES

- Police of the county arrested 31,853 persons during the calendar year 1993, a decrease of less than one-half of one percent compared to the previous year.
- · Adult arrests increased 1 percent and juvenile arrests decreased 5 percent.
- The total clearance rate for Index offenses was 19 percent; juveniles were responsible for 24 percent
  of those cases cleared.

# **HUNTERDON COUNTY**

#### **VOLUME/RATE**

- There were 1,760 Index crimes reported during 1993, an increase of one percent when compared with 1992.
- Violent crime decreased 12 percent and nonviolent crime increased one percent compared to the previous year.
- The county's crime rate, 16.3 victims for every 1,000 persons, increased one percent over 1992.
- Aggravated assault and motor vehicle theft decreased 14 and 8 percent respectively.
- Stolen property amounted to \$2.5 million with 27 percent of this property being recovered.

#### ARRESTS/CLEARANCES

- There were 2,362 persons arrested by Hunterdon County law enforcement agencies in 1993, a 12 percent decrease compared to the previous year.
- · Adult arrests decreased 7 percent while juvenile arrests showed a 30 percent decrease.
- The total clearance rate for Index offenses was 23 percent; juveniles were responsible for 21 percent of those cases cleared.

# **MERCER COUNTY**

#### **VOLUME/RATE**

• There were 17,020 Crime Index offenses reported during 1993. This represents a 7 percent decrease when compared to 1992.

- Violent crime registered a one percent decrease and nonviolent crime decreased 8 percent.
- The crime rate for Mercer County was 52.2 victims for every 1,000 persons, a 7 percent decrease compared to the previous year.
- · Rape increased 12 percent and larceny-theft decreased 13 percent.
- The total value of property stolen during the commission of Index crimes amounted to \$30.3 million;
   of this 70 percent was recovered.

- Police arrested 23,012 persons for criminal offenses, a decrease of less than one-half of one percent compared to 1992.
- Adult arrests increased one percent while juvenile arrests decreased 2 percent.

# MIDDLESEX COUNTY

#### **VOLUME/RATE**

- Middlesex County law enforcement agencies reported 26,950 Index offenses during 1993, an 8
  percent decrease compared to 1992.
- Violent crime increased 8 percent and nonviolent crime decreased 10 percent.
- The crime rate of 40.1 victims for every 1,000 inhabitants revealed an 8 percent decrease when compared to the previous year.
- Murder increased 36 percent (from 11 in 1992 to 15 in 1993), while motor vehicle theft decreased 18 percent when compared to the previous year.
- Total stolen property values amounted to \$40.8 million, with 35 percent of this being recovered.

- Total persons arrested, 26,709 in 1993, reflected an increase of 3 percent when compared to the previous year.

## MONMOUTH COUNTY

#### **VOLUME/RATE**

- During 1993 there were 20,148 Index crimes reported, representing a 5 percent decrease compared to 1992.
- There was a 9 percent decrease in violent crime and a 4 percent decrease in nonviolent crime.
- A victimization rate of 36.4 persons per 1,000 inhabitants reflected a 5 percent decrease over 1992.
- Rape decreased 15 percent (from 143 in 1992 to 122 in 1993), while aggravated assault decreased
   12 percent.
- Stolen property values, as a result of Index offenses, totaled \$21.3 million; of this 27 percent was recovered.

#### ARRESTS/CLEARANCES

 There were 31,210 persons arrested during the year, reflecting a 5 percent increase when compared to 1992.

- Adult arrests registered a 6 percent increase while juvenile arrests decreased less than one-half of one percent.
- The total clearance rate for Index offenses was 25 percent; juveniles were responsible for 26 percent of those cases cleared.

# **MORRIS COUNTY**

#### **VOLUME/RATE**

- A total of 9,976 Index crimes were reported to the police of Morris County, a 9 percent decrease when compared to 1992.
- There was a 14 percent decrease in violent crime and nonviolent crime decreased 8 percent.
- There were 23.7 victims of Index offenses for every 1,000 persons during 1993, an 8 percent decrease compared to 1992.
- Aggravated assault decreased 18 percent, while motor vehicle theft increased 7 percent.
- Total stolen property values amounted to \$14.4 million during the year; of this total 27 percent was recovered.

#### ARRESTS/CLEARANCES

- During the year police of the county made 14,300 arrests; this represents a 3 percent increase when compared to 1992.

## **OCEAN COUNTY**

#### **VOLUME/RATE**

- During 1993 there were 15,764 Index crimes reported, a decrease of 4 percent compared to the previous year.
- In 1993, violent crime increased less than one-half of one percent and nonviolent crime decreased
   4 percent.
- There were 36.4 victims of Index offenses for every 1,000 inhabitants, a 3 percent decrease when compared to 1992.
- Robbery increased 20 percent, while motor vehicle theft decreased 11 percent.
- Stolen property values totaled \$11.5 million, with 20 percent of the total being recovered.

#### ARRESTS/CLEARANCES

- Police of the county made 18,454 arrests during 1993, reflecting a decrease of one percent compared to 1992.

- There were 34.5 victims of Index offenses for every 1,000 inhabitants of the county, a 3 percent increase when compared to 1992.
- · Aggravated assault increased 26 percent, while rape decreased 33 percent.

- Police arrested 4,590 persons for criminal offenses during the calendar year 1993, a 10 percent increase over 1992.

# SOMERSET COUNTY

- During 1993 there were 7,702 Index offenses reported in the county, a decrease of 8 percent.
- Violent crime registered an increase of 9 percent while nonviolent crime recorded a decrease of 8 percent.
- For every 1,000 inhabitants 32.1 persons were victims of Index offenses, a decrease of 7 percent.
- · Robbery increased 18 percent, and motor vehicle theft decreased 21 percent.

- Law enforcement agencies of the county reported 2,558 Index crimes during 1993, a decrease of 7 percent compared to the previous year.
- Violent crime decreased 2 percent while nonviolent crime recorded an 8 percent decrease for the year.
- For every 1,000 persons 19.5 were victims of Index offenses, an 8 percent decrease compared to 1992.

- Police of the county arrested 23,129 persons during 1993, a decrease of 8 percent.

- · Adult arrests registered a one percent decrease while juvenile arrests increased 4 percent.
