



Camden County Women's Center, Camden County's state designated non-profit agency for providing services and shelter to victims of domestic violence, is seeking volunteers to join the Domestic Violence Response Team (DVRT).

DVRT members are trained volunteer advocates who schedule themselves to be available "on-call" to meet confidentially with victims of domestic violence at police headquarters as needed. The volunteer advocates work in conjunction with the police to provide support, information and referrals to victims of domestic violence.

40-hour domestic violence training class is offered to interested volunteers twice a year, in the Fall and Spring. Training occurs in evening hours and occasionally on weekends.
