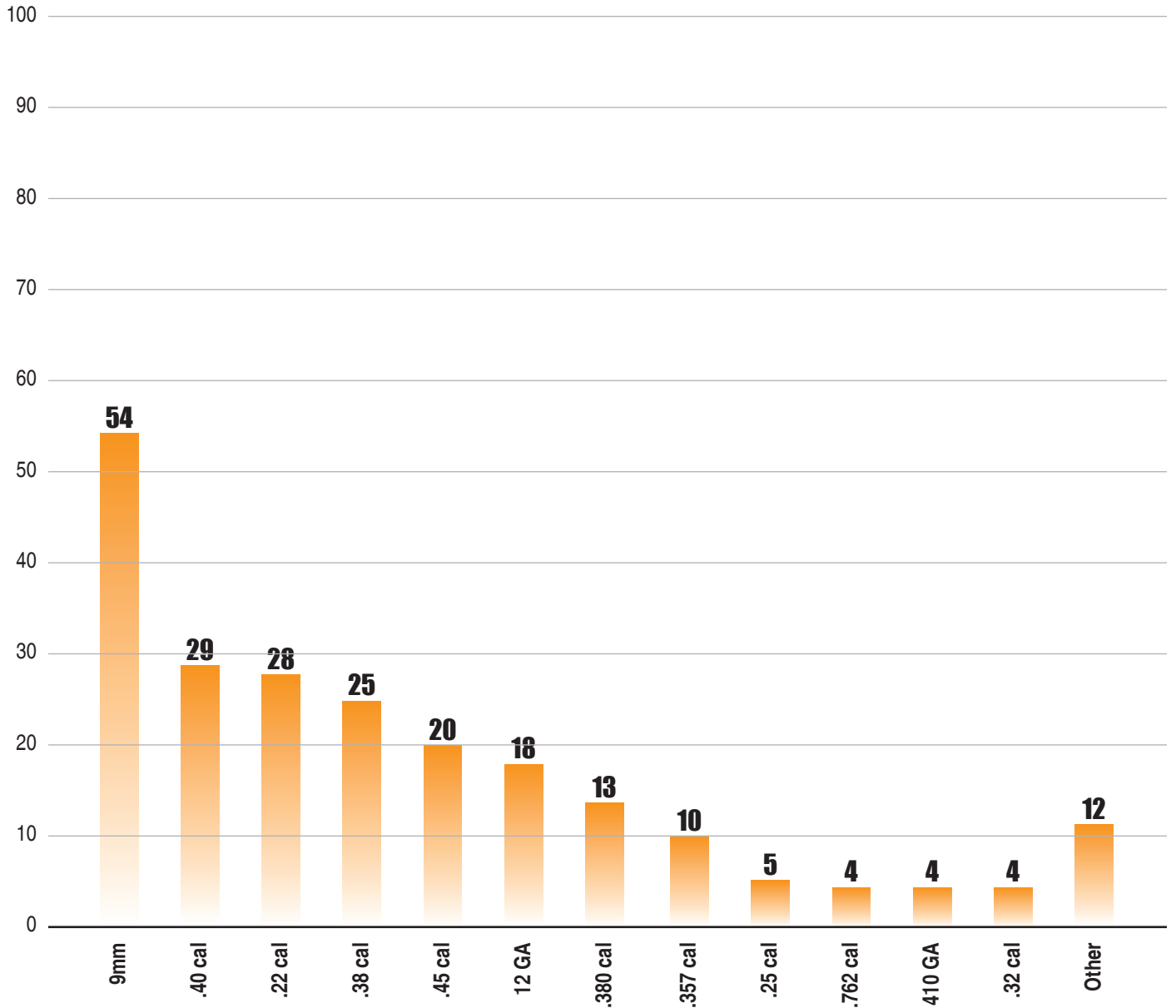

Weapon Breakdown by Caliber



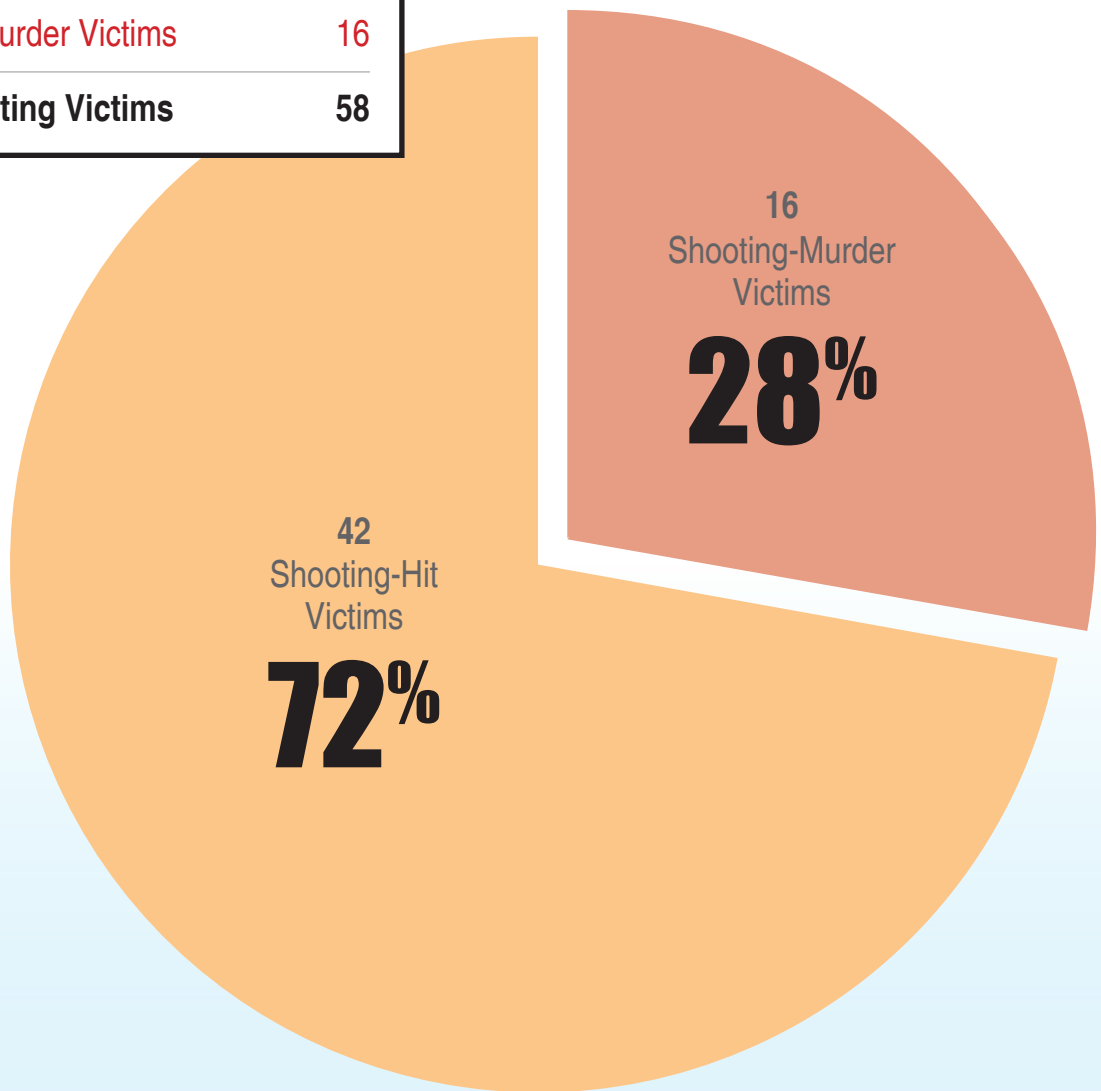

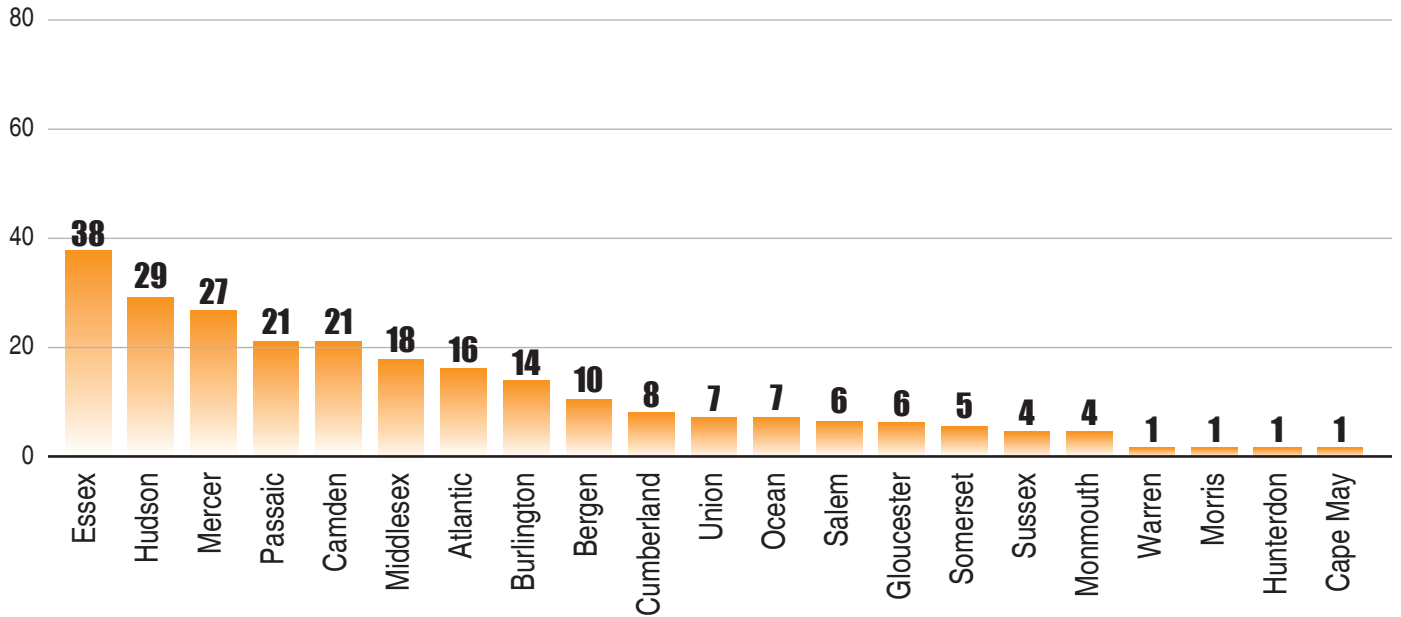

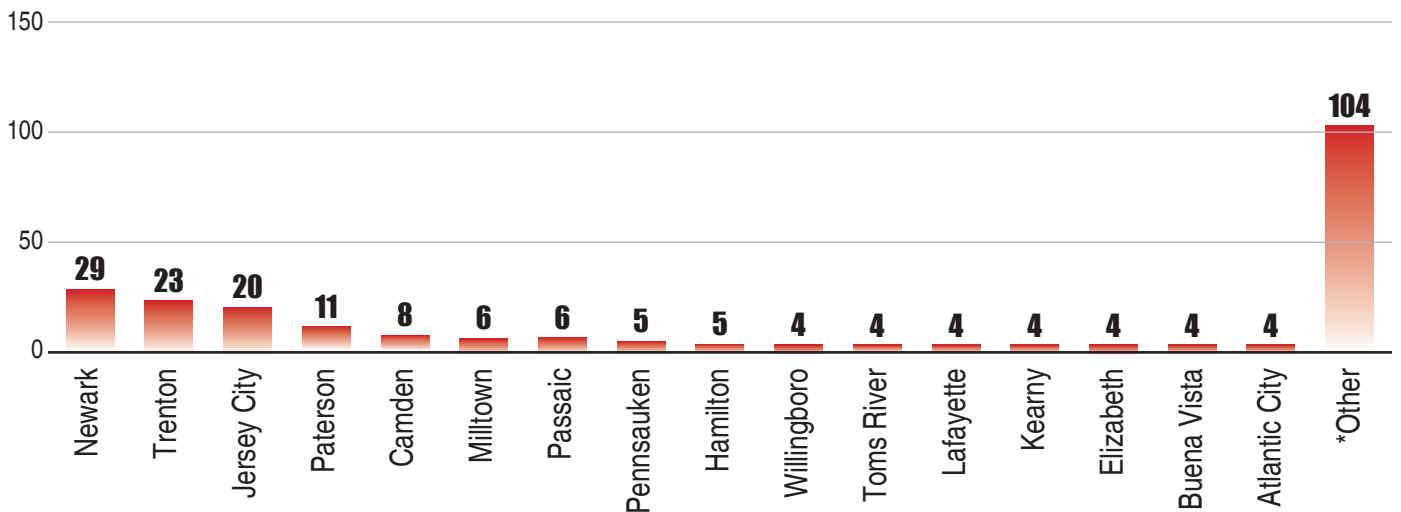
