Section III: Talkgroup Requests

Definitions:

- **Talkgroup** – a configurable, pre-programmed, voice pathway in the System by which properly programmed radios can communicate with each other, often referred to as a channel.
- **Interoperability Talkgroups** – existing Statewide, Regional, and Highway talkgroups available for programming with proper authorization for no additional fee:

- **New Talkgroups** – talkgroups that you would like to have added to the system for your agency’s use. You may authorize other agencies to program your new talkgroups into their radios for mutual aid.
- **Shared Talkgroups** – any other agency’s existing talkgroups you would like to program into your radios, with that agency’s written authorization, for mutual aid.

Section IV: System Impact

Definitions:

- **Dispatch Console** – the position from which a dispatcher operates.
- **Portable Radio** – a handheld radio carried manually or on a belt clip.
- **Mobile Radio** – a radio generally mounted in a vehicle.
- **Control Station** – a radio mounted in a building or equipment shelter and connected to one or more dispatch consoles. A control station connects the dispatch console to the radio system over the air (not wired). An alternative to control stations is to tie the dispatch consoles directly to the radio system core (wired).
