

Notice to Municipal Clerks, ABC Board Secretary's and Chief Law Enforcement Officers

RE: TEMPORARY STORAGE PERMIT - Online Applications Require Endorsement

The ABC Online Licensing System application process for Temporary Storage Permits is now updated to include the endorsement feature that was implemented on March 15, 2019 for special permits.

A licensee can obtain this permit in the case of temporary need to store alcoholic beverages somewhere other than the licensed premise. As with the temporary storage permit paper application, applications applied for online also require the endorsement of the Municipal Clerk or ABC Board Secretary and the Chief Law Enforcement Officer, or their designee before the Division can issue the permit.
