**AN 2021-01 – ADVISORY NOTICE TO SEASONAL RETAIL CONSUMPTION
LICENSEES REGARDING EXTENSION OF LICENSE TERM**

On December 30, 2020, Governor Murphy signed into law P.L.2020, c.146 (Assembly [Bill No. 4589](#)), which permits the holders of summer seasonal retail consumption licenses (“summer seasonal licensees”) to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises and off-premises consumption in accordance with N.J.S.A. 33:1-12 from May 1, 2020 until January 14, 2022. This new legislation temporarily extends the term in N.J.S.A. 33:1-12 (normally May 1 until November 14 of each year) in which these summer seasonal licensees may operate.

Accordingly, this new legislation temporarily suspends the need for summer seasonal licensees to apply to the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control for one-day permits to sell alcoholic beverages outside of their normal summer season. Summer seasonal licensees will be required to apply for one-day permits after January 14, 2022. Summer seasonal licensees are advised to keep a copy of this Notice with their license certificate.
