BY THE DIRECTOR:

This matter involves an amendment to a prior Special Ruling (SR 2021-05) authorizing qualified permittees to sell and dispense alcoholic beverages at the annual Woodbridge Township Mayor’s Summer Concert Series from June 21, 2021 to September 5, 2021. That Special Ruling authorized an extraordinary remedy whereby the concert series was viewed for regulatory purposes as a single event, enabling participating permittees to sell alcoholic beverages from the same fenced-in area on non-consecutive dates for 11 weeks.<sup>1</sup> Woodbridge Township requested this accommodation in 2020 (SR 2020-12) and again in 2021 (SR 2021-05) so it could host its annual concert series at a centralized location to accommodate social distancing made necessary by the novel coronavirus 19 (“COVID-19”) pandemic.

Due to inclement weather and rescheduled concert dates, Woodbridge Township is now requesting the remedy in SR 2021-05 be extended to September 30th. Based on the good cause demonstrated, SR 2021-05 is hereby amended to authorize an extension of the annual concert series permits to September 30, 2021. All other terms and conditions in the permits issued pursuant to SR 2021-05 shall remain in full force and effect.

<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 33:1-74, no more than 25 temporary permits may be sited at the same premises in a calendar year.

The relief granted herein is based on the representations made by Woodbridge Township. The Division recognizes that this is an extraordinary remedy and any requests for future relief of this type will be based on the factual circumstances that exist at that time.
