BY THE ACTING DIRECTOR:

On May 4, 2015, the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (the "Division") issued an Order that, among other things, extended all State-issued permits that were issued and renewed for the 2014-2015 license term until September 18, 2015, unless renewed earlier. The State-issued permits covered by that Order included:

- Omnibus Permit [OMB];
- Gratuitous Gifts Permit [GG];
- Gratuitous Samples Permit [GS];
- Product Information/Introduction Permit [PI];
- Charitable/Trade Donations Permit [DON];
- Sampling Permit [SP];
- Consumer Tasting Permit for Wholesale Licensees [CTW];
- Charitable and Civic Event Sampling Permit for Restricted Brewery Licensees [CCR];
- Charitable and Civic Event Sampling Permit for Limited Brewery Licensees [CCL];
- Sacramental Wine Permit [SC];
- Transportation License Insignias [TLI];
- Winery Salesrooms/Retail Outlets (plenary winery, farm winery, and out of state winery licensees only);
- Marketing Agent Permit [MA];
- Solicitor Permit [SOL];
- Transit Insignia [TI]; and
- Marketing Agent ID Cards.

In addition the following permits must also be extended for the reasons set forth below:

- Co-op Permits [CO-OP];
- Food and Pharmaceutical Permit [FP]
- Limited Transportation Permit [LTP]
- Off Premise Storage of Records Permit [OPS]

Most of these permits are associated with State-issued wholesale or manufacturing licenses or municipal-issued retail licenses that have been renewed for the 2015-2016 license term.

As described in the May 4, 2015 Order, the Division is in the process of implementing its new computer system, known as POSSE ABC, which will allow holders of municipal and State liquor licenses, and holders of State-issued permits, to renew their licenses or permits electronically. This new system represents a much-needed modernization of the current business practices at the Division. Over the last several months, the Division has successfully rolled out POSSE ABC, which has allowed most holders of State and municipal licenses to renew electronically. However, there have been unforeseen delays in the implementation of POSSE ABC for the renewal of State-issued permits, such that it has become apparent that State-issued permits will not be renewed by the September 18, 2015 deadline set forth in the May 4<sup>th</sup> Order. As such, in order for the authorizations contained in the State-issued permits to continue uninterrupted, I have determined that the September 18, 2015 deadline must be extended in order to allow the Division to continue its implementation of electronic renewals of State-issued permits through POSSE ABC.


The Director's authority to issue this Order was discussed in detail in the May 4<sup>th</sup> Order, which is incorporated herein by reference.

Accordingly, it is on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015,

ORDERED that State-issued permits issued for the 2014-2015 license term shall be

extended under this Third Amended Order until the Division completes the implementation of electronic renewals of State-issued permits through POSSE ABC, or until February 1, 2016, whichever is earlier; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, the Director may issue additional Orders to clarify and address problems not anticipated by this Order.
