Program Summary

This presentation will review and analyze the past year's most significant New Jersey employment law decisions. It will also analyze current hot topics in employment law, including post-*Stengart* email policies, social media and networking issues, the impact of federal Whistleblowing bounties on CEPA claims, the new emphasis on equal pay claims, and practical application of new rules on the statute of limitations.
