Program Summary

This two-day seminar series is the second phase of an integrated three-phase course designed for new assistant prosecutors and deputy attorneys general, which culminates with an intensive four-day trial advocacy program. Among the topics addressed during this session will be juvenile justice, appellate practice, bail issues, bias crimes, the criminal code, grand jury matters, *Wade/ID* issues, confessions and *Miranda*, and trial ethics. Who Should Attend?

This program is intended for new assistant prosecutors and Division of Criminal Justice deputies, attendance for which has already been determined by each county prosecutor's office and the Division of Criminal Justice.

Who Is the Faculty?

The faculty consists of experienced assistant prosecutors, Division of Criminal Justice attorneys, and private sector attorneys who have extensive expertise in the subject matter on which they are presenting.
