Program Summary

This program focuses on enhancing the skills needed to elicit information and obtain admissions effectively through depositions. Participants will develop and sharpen their deposition skills by conducting deposition examinations and defending depositions in a simulated setting, followed by faculty guidance and feedback. The workshop exercises will focus on addressing preliminary matters, techniques for effectively eliciting complete information from witnesses, making and responding to objections, dealing with difficult adversaries, using exhibits, and obtaining admissions. The program also includes presentations on the components of effective depositions.

Who Should Attend?

This program is for Division of Law deputies who have been selected to attend by their supervisors.

Who Is the Faculty?

The faculty consists of Division of Law deputy and assistant attorneys general and other attorneys who have extensive deposition experience.
