## **Program Summary**

This seminar will include an overview of emergency management authorities at the State and federal levels, including the New Jersey Civilian Defense and Disaster Control Act and the Federal Stafford Act. Topics of discussion will include the process for declaring a State of Emergency, the powers invoked under a Governor's emergency declaration, requesting a Presidential Declaration of an Emergency or Major Disaster, and a walk through of the Federal Emergency Management Agency's disaster assistance programs.
