Program Summary

This is the final day of the DCF Trial Advocacy Skills Program. Students will conduct a mock trial, using the litigation skills they have demonstrated in the course workshops.

Eligibility

This program is for deputy attorneys general in the Division of Law's Department of Children and Families practice group selected to attend by their leadership. Students will receive the course materials prior to the program date.

Faculty

The faculty consists of Division of Law DCF Practice Group deputy and assistant attorneys general who have extensive trial experience.

CLE Credit

NJ CLE Credit: This program has been approved by the Board on Continuing Legal Education of the Supreme Court of New Jersey for 3.6 hours of total CLE credit.
