#### ***Program Summary***

This is the final day of the Criminal Trial Advocacy Skills Program. Students will conduct a mock trial, using the litigation skills they have demonstrated in the course workshops.

#### ***Eligibility***

This program is for new assistant prosecutors and Division of Criminal Justice deputies selected to attend by each county prosecutor's office and the Division of Criminal Justice. Registrants will receive the course materials prior to the program date.

#### ***Faculty***

The faculty consists of assistant prosecutors, Division of Criminal Justice deputy and assistant attorneys general and other attorneys who have extensive trial experience.

### ***CLE Credit***

NJ CLE Credit: This program has been approved by the Board on Continuing Legal Education of the Supreme Court of New Jersey for 3.9 hours of total CLE credit. .
