Program Summary

Achieving success as a lawyer in many ways depends upon the success of your law firm. This program shares insights into the structure and management of law offices as well as how to succeed in such an environment. Topics include the legal structure of a law firm, the bona fide office rule, fee agreements, attorney trust accounts and ethical considerations. The presenter will also discuss communication with clients, calendar and tickler systems and conflicts.
