Program Summary

This program will focus on how to analyze and answer law enforcement and Department of Corrections complaints. The presenter will discuss how to determine the correct venue, whether to file an Answer or Motion to Dismiss, whether to include additional parties, or file a counter-claim. He will detail the steps to take after a plaintiff files an Amended Complaint, and advise deputies of the procedures they must follow and the approvals they are required to obtain before taking certain actions as they proceed to handle an assigned case.

Eligibility

Attendance at this program is mandatory for deputies in the Division of Law's Law Enforcement & Corrections Section who have been hired after August 1, 2024. Other deputies in the LEC section are welcome to attend.
