Program Summary

This intensive oral advocacy program consists of participatory workshops designed to improve attorneys' oral argument skills. Students will present arguments in support of or in opposition to a motion for summary judgment. After presenting their argument, students will receive feedback from experienced deputy and assistant attorneys general.

Eligibility

Attendance at this program is limited to Division of Law deputies selected to attend by their section chiefs.

Faculty

The faculty consists of Division of Law deputy and assistant attorneys general and other attorneys who have extensive oral argument experience.
