Civil Rights Roundtable - July 13, 2016

Representatives of the Division on Civil Rights will take part in a Civil Rights Roundtable on Wednesday, July 13 at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Somerset, 110 Rehill Avenue, in Somerville. The event is open to the public.

The Civil Rights Roundtable is a joint partnership of several federal, state and local agencies responsible for enforcing civil rights laws and providing community intervention services in New Jersey and New York, as well as Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands (known as federal Region II).

New Jersey Division on Civil Rights Assistant Director Estelle Bronstein and Supervising Investigator Elizabeth Russian will be panelists at the Roundtable event. Assistant Director Bronstein will speak about housing rights issues, and Supervising Investigator Russian will discuss employment discrimination issues.

The Roundtable will focus on civil rights issues for LGBT communities, with a particular emphasis on enforcement of anti-discrimination protections for transgender and gender non-conforming individuals. The Roundtable is scheduled to begin at 10 a.m. and conclude at 4 p.m.
